\$58

Raising \$58 can help a shelter dog learn to trust again with specialised training.



\$90

Raising \$90 can help transport injured and abused animals to get medical care.



\$252

Raising \$252 will help us care for a dog in one of our shelters for a whole week.



\$1,008

Raising \$1,008 will help us to care for a mistreated, abused or abandoned dog in our shelters for a whole month!

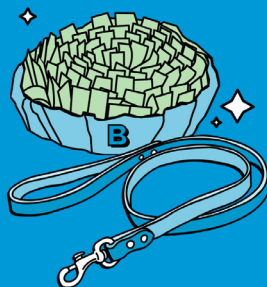

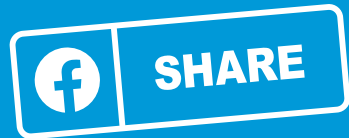

HELP CHANGE THE LIVES OF ANIMALS LIKE SHINTO



Like so many of the animals that come through our doors at RSPCA, Shinto was in desperate need of care, love and compassion. He was scared of people and of the world itself - it was heartbreaking to see.

When Shinto arrived via our Inspectorate, it was clear that he was suffering. His skin was ravaged by a severe skin disease called mange. Thanks to the tireless care of our veterinary and behaviour teams, he received extensive treatment: ear and eye care, blood work, x-rays, and necessary medications. The team worked patiently with him, gaining his trust bit by bit.

Slowly, his skin began to heal, and as his physical wounds closed, so did the emotional wounds. He was blossoming in care and loved walkies with our volunteers, soft blankets, peanut butter and toys.

Yet, despite all the care and progress, Shinto's journey wasn't without its setbacks. He was adopted once, but after struggling to adapt to a home with young children, he was returned. It was a difficult moment, but we knew his perfect match was still out there.

And then came the moment of destiny. Shinto was adopted by someone, who like Shinto, had a quiet, calm presence that made them an ideal pair. *"Shinto is GREAT, I keep pinching myself thinking I'm dreaming how suited we are for each other. We're both loving life."* This was it. The match made in heaven.

Shinto's transformation is a testament to the change that can come when animals are given the right care. Today, Shinto is no longer the frightened dog he once was. He is thriving, loved beyond measure, and living the life he always deserved. It's a reminder that no matter how dark the beginning, there is always hope for a brighter future.
